Advice for Automotive Gateway Students

- 🚗 Write your full name and school name on all workbooks.
- 🚗 Answer all the review questions in the workbook before handing it in for marking. All the answers to the questions are in the workbook. If you are not sure ask your teacher or workshop supervisor.
- 🚗 You must get 80% in your workbook before you can sit the assessment.
- 🚗 If you have any questions for our tutors regarding the workbooks you can email tutors@fairviews.co.nz
- 🚗 When you receive your marked workbook (and have achieved a mark of at least 80%) you should then study the workbook thoroughly. If you have not achieved 80% redo those questions that were missed and resubmit the workbook for marking.

- 🚗 To pass the unit standard you must show that you are competent against each element of the unit standard. Provide as much detail as possible in your answers and try to answer all questions set.
- 🚗 The assessment must be completed as a closed book exercise under exam conditions. You must **sign** the assessment instructions on page 2.
- 🚗 You are allowed only ONE reassessment (different assessment paper).
- 🚗 The workbooks are yours to keep so look after them.
